	Show off your presentation skills by creating a PowerPoint (max. 5 slides) about a subject of your own choosing – it could be a hobby or favourite topic. If you don't have access to a computer, you could always create a five page paper presentation. Mr Richards could then scan the pages so they can be shown to the class on the smartboard. Either way, make sure your slides/pages are clear and interesting to read.	Spend some time in your garden or a local park and observe the animals that visit. Can you spot what they are doing? You could present your findings to the class in a variety of ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write a short report about what you noticed.</li><li>• Draw a picture of some of the animals and the place they visited.</li><li>• Make a chart (using your statistics learning) to show the different species that visited.</li></ul>
