

Online Number Facts challenges

These Microsoft Forms challenges allow children to practice their recall of key number facts. Monitoring your child as they complete each challenge will help you to judge whether they are ready to move on to the next one.

If, whilst answering questions, your child hesitates for lengthy periods or uses their fingers to count then, ideally, that form should be repeated to promote swifter recall and build confidence.
