| <b>Could do activities (during the term)</b> | <p>DT activities – You could choose one of these!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Stone Age people build shelters to live in using materials they had gathered. Gather some natural materials and build a model shelter.</li> <li>2. Design and make an ancient stone circle or a replica of Stonehenge. Be creative in the way you make your stone circle.</li> <li>3. The wheel was invented during the Stone Age. What is a wheel used for? Build something that uses a wheel/wheels.</li> </ol> | <p>We know that the first recordings of art were Cave Art. Design a piece of cave art using materials of your choice. i.e. paint, chalk, crayon.</p> <p>Make up your own story, it can be about anything you like but tell it through cave art pictures!</p>  |
|  | <p>Stone Age people could not pop to the shop for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your own recipe for a stone age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them.</p>  | <p>In Science we are going to be investigating sound. Can you create your own musical instrument using things you can find at home?</p> <p>You could use different sized pans or fill glass bottles with different amounts of water. You could also create your own instruments using items of rubbish and elastic bands. Get creative.</p> |

**TOP TIP!** Most of these projects may take a few goes before they are finished, that's normal. Plan out what you want to do before you start, chat through your ideas with someone else if you want to **but the end result must be your own work**. Take your time, redraft if you need to. Produce your best work and have fun!
