TERMLY	<u>Stone Age jewellery</u> Stone Age jewellery was simple in design and made from seashells, animal bones or clay. Your task is to design and make your own Stone Age necklace, be as creative as you want in your design and finished piece.	<u>Sweet changes of state</u> With your parents' permission and assistance , scientifically test what happens if you freeze different sweet items such as honey, jam and Haribos. Record your predictions and your observations. Can you draw any conclusions from your results? Remember to use the correct scientific vocabulary.
	<u>Stone Age rocks!</u> Imagine you were a musician in the Stone Age. Compose and record your own piece of music using whatever instruments you want, (these can be conventional instruments or ones you create). There are some good examples online that may inspire you!	<u>Super Stonehenge</u> Stonehenge is one of the world's most famous monuments. Build your own model of Stonehenge using whatever material(s) you like, these could be general craft materials or foods such as biscuits - the choice is yours!

TOP TIP! Most of these projects may take a few goes before they are finished, that's normal. Plan out what you want to do before you start, chat through your ideas with someone else if you want to **but the end result must be your own work**. Take your time, redraft if you need to. Produce your best work and have fun!
