TERMLY	<u>Bronze Age/Iron Age rap</u> Following the success of the Stone Age raps we learnt last term, your challenge is to write your own Bronze Age/Iron Age rap. Be as creative as you want to be! Please write the lyrics in your home learning book. We would love to hear you perform the rap in class!	<u>Super sounds</u> Take a walk around your house (indoors and outdoors) to identify and describe the different sounds. How many different sounds can you hear? Are these high or low pitch sounds? Describe how these sounds make you feel. Which is your favourite sound and why? Remember to use the correct scientific vocabulary.
	<u>Build your own roundhouse</u> Roundhouses were found throughout Britain during the Bronze Age to the Iron Age. Design (in your home learning book) and then build your own roundhouse. Be as creative as you want when choosing which materials to use. There are lots of ideas online that may inspire you.	<u>Awesome animation</u> Using information you have learnt about the Bronze Age/Iron Age, as well as stories you may have read, design and produce your own animation. If you do not have access to a computer, you could draw a comic strip instead.

Plan out what you want to do before you start, chat through your ideas with someone else if you want to **but the end result must be your own work**. Take your time, redraft if you need to.
