I hope you enjoyed the summer and that the children are well rested and ready for our new topic 'Stone Age to Iron Age'.

During the course of this term, we will be learning all about Stone Age and Iron Age civilisations. Where major settlements were and what features the settlements had in common. In History, we will be looking at the role of an archaeologist and thinking about the changes that occurred over the period. Our English will be based around the book *Wolf Brother* which we will be using to write narratives and poems.

In Maths we will be focussing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, and Statistics.

In art and design, we will be designing our own cave painting and exploring the materials that were used by Stone Age people. We will be visiting Oxenwood and investigating aspects of Stone Age Life, which we will use to build either a PowerPoint or website in Computing. In Music, we will be composing our own lyrics for a song linked to the Stone Age which we will then perform!

In Science, we will be considering States of Matter. When looking at States of Matter the children will be considering solids, liquids and gases and changing states.

PE this term will be on Thursdays and Fridays. On Thursdays, we will be doing Archery and on Fridays we will doing Real PE to help develop our PE skills across a number of sports.
