Thank you to Mr. Richards for organizing and running yesterday's online safety event. Years 1-6 each shared some online safety learning with parents through a variety of forms such as song, artwork, a quiz and drama. This was followed on by a discussion about online safety with the parents at the event.

Our Year 5 children had a fantastic 'taster day' at Sheldon School this week where they experienced lessons in Science, PE, Art, Drama and DT. Sheldon School staff reported that our children were a credit to our school in terms of their learning and attitudes. Finally, Rainbow Class had a visit from a doctor this week, as part of their topic 'People who help us'. They enjoyed learning about their bodies and the checks doctors do to make sure we are well.
